INTRODUCTION

Lohfa ministry is an independent, non- Denomination Organisation with vision and the mission of helping and assisting (especially the youth) in reshaping, refocusing and re-orientating the people towards positive thinking, usefulness to themselves, communities, nation and the world at large through the most potent way of teaching from the TRUTH, the whole TRUTH which is the word of God

MEMBERSHIP

Church membership shall be open to all who profess repentance towards God and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

MINISTRY

The ministry will be shared between the pastor and elders. The pastor assumes the responsibility and authority of office (minister, workers and members) within the church. The pastor shall hold to and teach the doctrines contained in the Basis of Faith.

The government of the church shall be in the charge of the elders, of whom the pastor shall be one, who shall hold to and maintain the doctrines contained in the Basis of Faith.

Each regular leader or teacher in a recognised department of the church shall be appointed by the Pastor and elders. Only church members shall be eligible for appointment. Before appointment of any leader, teacher, or helper to work with children or young people, the applicant must be vetted.

CHURCH MEETINGS

Notice of any church meeting shall be given on at least one preceding Sunday prior to the meeting. At the discretion of the Pastor/elders an emergency meeting may be called, and this rule waived.

A financial statement for the previous calendar year(duly audited by auditors appointed at a previous church meeting) shall be presented at the A.G.M.

Sunday services are held on Sundays 14:30 till 16:30 (subject to venue change)

Bible studies are held every Tuesday 19:00 till 20:00

Vigils are held every 1st Friday of the month 23:00 till 01:00
